AIMS

4. Develop a strong golf specific School Club Links programme across Derbyshire.
5. Develop a strong golf specific Community links programme across Derbyshire.
6. Develop a Derbyshire Golf forum for PDM's and SSCO's.
7. Linking festivals & competitions into the Player Pathway.

OUTCOMES

1. Each SSP to have at least 1 club as an exit route.
2. Create a strong working relationship with the Derbyshire Schools Golf Association.
3. To increase the number of people participating in golf and wanting to join golf clubs in Derbyshire.
4. More qualified Level 1 coaches.

Communicate the vision of the Derbyshire Golf Partnership to appropriate personnel and agencies.
